## Executive summary

Your estate grew by 38 resources this month, driven by a new autoscaling group in prod-us-east-1 backing the payments launch. Monthly spend rose 2.1% to \$81,414, in line with the growth. Open security findings fell by 4, including one critical (rotated IAM root access key on legacy-ops). One cost anomaly — BigQuery scan spend on April 14 — was actioned within SLA. Rightsizing and idle opportunities totalling \$11,280/month remain open; the top three are called out below.

## Architecture changes

12 resources added, 4 removed. Full diff in appendix A. The architecture diagram, refreshed on every scan, is attached at 300 DPI as acme-2026-03.png. Notable: a new VPC peering in acct 4411 between prod-us-east-1 and stage-us-east-1 — confirm this is intentional.

## Security posture

The two oldest critical findings (public-bucket, root-access-key) have owners and target closure dates of April 20 and April 22 respectively.

## Cost story

Rightsizing opportunities worth \$3,890/month. Idle candidates worth \$6,240/month. Commitment coverage at 71% on AWS — 4% under target.

## Top three actions

- Downsize 7 EKS nodes in prod-eks-web from m6i.2xlarge to m6i.xlarge — \$1,820/mo.
- Stop or snapshot 14 idle GCS buckets in data-prod unread in 90+ days — \$640/mo.
- Expand 1-year CUD coverage on gke-api — \$410/mo.

## Anomalies

BigQuery data-prod.analytics scanned 7.2 TB more than the 14-day baseline on April 14 ( $2.4\sigma$ ). Driver: a scheduled query missed its partition filter. Remediated by data-eng on the same day; added a GrandLine check to flag this pattern in future.

### ● What changed in how we report

This month's report uses the new Security overlay from the Architecture explorer — the same underlying topology model now renders Logical, Security, and Cost views, so the PDF, the dashboard, and the DOCX all stay in sync.
